To whomever embraces this devotion, I promise salvation.”

This wonderful opportunity will be offered February through June 2023 by our local vicariate as a response to this promise. Five local parishes have graciously offered to host & provide all the dedicated prayers to those yearning to grow closer to Mary, thus to Jesus, our Source & Summit.
